NATIONAL SURVEY FINDINGS: HOME FIRE RISK



Behaviors known to cause home fires **markedly declined** since the months immediately preceding the COVID-19-related lockdown in 2020.



45% decrease in people overloading electrical sockets¹



64% decrease in people falling asleep with a fire burning in the fireplace¹



75% decrease in people leaving a lit candle near drapes and other flammable household items¹

¹ The Hartford conducted an online survey of fire safety and prevention behaviors among a representative sample of 15,001 U.S. adults, age 18 and over, between December 7 and December 23, 2022. The margin of error is +/- 0.8 percent at the 95% confidence level.

² The Hartford Home Fire Index is based on a combination of FEMA's National Fire Incident Reporting System data (NFIRS) and the survey results from residents in the cities within the largest 150 MSAs based on number of housing units. A rate of residential structure fires per 10,000 housing units was calculated for each MSA/city using the reported number of annual residential structure fires reported in NFIRS with the total number of housing units reported in the 2020 U.S. Census ACS DP-4 Demographic table. Standardized fire rates and survey scores were combined to produce a ranked, composite Home Fire Risk score for each MSA/city.

³ Based on The Hartford's claims data from 2020-2022 at the time the claim was reported.
